## Introduction

The Language Explorer Competition is an annual, online national school-level competition that introduces language and linguistics knowledge to primary school, secondary school and pre-university students in Malaysia. This competition aims to introduce the world of Language and Computational Linguistics as early as possible to the younger generations.

The winners in secondary categories from this competition will be selected for the Malaysian Computational Linguistics Olympiad (MyCLO), and also Asia Pacific Linguistics Olympiad (APLO). Students will also have an opportunity to be trained by professionals in the linguistics field. MyCLO is a platform to choose the best four students to represent Malaysia in the International Linguistics Olympiad (IOL) that will be hosted in Taipei on July 2025.

# **Objectives**

- Cultivate analytical and problem-solving skills in language through complex linguistics challenges
- Introduce students to linguistics and computational linguistics, inspiring interest from an early age
- Strengthen Higher-order Thinking Skills (HOTS) by engaging students in creative and abstract language tasks
- Identify and train talented students for participation in national and international linguistics competitions

# Achievement of The Malaysian Team in the International Linguistic Olympiad (IOL) 2024

This year, 17 students took part in the 6<sup>th</sup> Asia Pacific Linguistics Olympiad (APLO), held on 7<sup>th</sup> April 2024. These students were selected from the Language Explorer Competition 2024, out of 448 participants. One of these talented participants achieved a gold medal in APLO, marking a significant accomplishment in the competition.

Following the event, from 4<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> May, a special online training session was organized for the top 9 students who had stood out in the APLO. This training aimed to further refine their skills and prepare them for the next challenge. After a selection process based on their performance during the training, 4 of the best students were chosen to represent Malaysia at the prestigious International Linguistics Olympiad (IOL) in Brasília, Brazil. The students also attended another round of national training camp and the APLO Joint Training Camp, where they met new friends.

The IOL took place from 23<sup>rd</sup> - 30<sup>th</sup> July 2024, and brought together talented students from around the world. The Malaysian team was represented by Miss Deborah Chow as the Team Leader, along with 4 students: Lim Ming Wen, Tan Yu Xuan, Adib Asyraf Bin Abdul Aziz, and Leang Kar Men.

Although the Malaysian team did not win any medal, the IOL in Brazil was an invaluable experience. It taught them so much and was incredibly fun. They also had the opportunity to learn about new cultures and meet many new friends, which has fueled their determination to keep improving and strive for better results next time.

# **Syllabus**

Questions can usually be answered using creative and critical thinking skills, so participants do not need to be multilingual

Computational Linguistics Competition can be describe as interesting puzzles using languages

The results will be announced in January 2025
